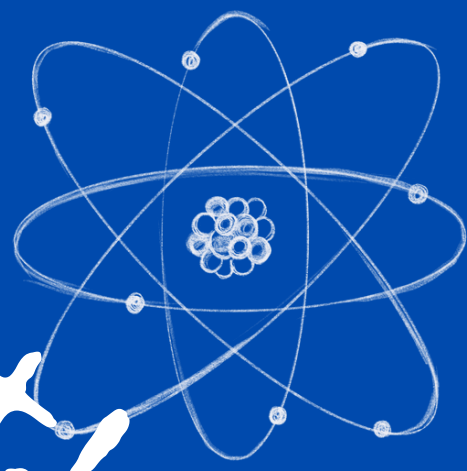


# GCCA Student Spotlight!
